"Grace and Courtesy lessons are the cornerstone to how everything flows in the classroom; to how we greet others' work, how to offer help, how to respect other, how to ask questions and how to solve disagreements. These lessons allow children to be a part of the classroom community and

use those skills in the larger community," said Sarah.

And these lessons are certainly effective! "What is impressive and fills me with pride is when a family comes for a school tour and one of the students will greet the adult by saying 'welcome





to our classroom!' If there is a child with them, our students will invite them to stay and play with the group. At that moment, I know that Montessori philosophy is truly working!"

The curriculum is extended even further with weekly lessons in biology, botany, Italian, yoga, dance, computers and music theory.

Sarah knew that Verona was the perfect place to enact this thoughtful and thorough curriculum. "When I attended Verona schools, there was a sense of mutual care and respect among students and teacher interactions. The teachers throughout grammar school and into the high school years had the intrinsic desire to see each student succeed and they opened the doors of possibility through their promise to educate, motivate and congratulate the strengths of each student. This is what I strive for all my students that attend Serenity Montessori Academy."

Although many decades have passed since Sarah attended Verona schools, she knows that this spirit continues in Verona to this day. Sarah said, "It is wonderful to see many alumni continue to reside in Verona or open up businesses in their same childhood town.
